Angela M. Tobin, daughter of Alfred and Mary Tobin. Born near Washington, D. C. in Virginia, March 1, 1835. She came with her parents in her very early childhood and settled in Maryland, Mason County, Missouri. Her mother rode a horse and carried her almost the entire distance from Virginia to Missouri. She grew to womanhood at home and married George C. Parker, November 29, 1853, to which union was born 11 children, 8 boys and 3 girls which all grew to manhood and womanhood and all married but one. There are more than 40 grand-children and many great-grandchildren.

There are four who have preceded her in death. Mrs. Ida Turner, Shelby, Missouri; Alonzo Parker, Ephraim, Utah; Mrs. Julia E. Veatch, Elva, Kansas; Rob Parker of Elva. There are living: L. A. Parker, Capton, Oklahoma; Sam P., Marceline, Missouri; William G. P., Hannibal, Missouri; Mrs. Bell Selzer, Elva, Missouri; Mrs. Annie Hensley, Blandineville, Illinois; Mrs. Almira King, Colchester, Kansas; Ernest Parker, Lookout, Oklahoma; Mrs. Sadie Tucker, Duffalo, Oklahoma; Roy C. Parker, Elva, Kansas; Arthur D. Parker, Elva, Kansas; also, a brother, Albert Tobin of Salt Lake City, Utah and a sister, Mrs. William Tobin Fowler of Moon, Missouri, deceased.

The family moved from Missouri to Kansas in April 1896 and settled in Comanche County, Kansas, near Evansville where they resided until the Cherokee Strip opened in 1903 when they took land there near the present post office of White Horse, Woods County. Later they moved near Elva, Kansas and again in Elva where her husband, Geo. C. Parker died on April 13, 1913. She remained in Elva for several years, living with her son, Alonzo; later she lived with her daughter, Mrs. King. In her last years, she was cared for

by her sons, Ernest and Ray and her daughter, Mrs. King. Passed away at her son's (Ray) place in Elmer, Kansas, May 30, 1930.

Bloomington, Boone County, Missouri on account of her father's ill health. He and his wife moved to Missouri. He and she rode horseback the entire distance from Alexandria, Virginia to Bloomington, Missouri.
