Research Notes

- Sources and documentation for the following are available at the <u>Family</u> Tree Database.
- The surname HARMON occurs just as often spelled as HARMAN; as the name regresses back up the family tree, it becomes the GERMAN surname HERMANN, HERRMANN.

Current Theory

Peter H. PARKER's middle name was most probably Harman or Harmon.

The incorrect use of Hiram as Peter's middle name is probably based on an 1850 census enumerator's error.

- In 1797 Greene County, TENNESSEE John PARKER married Margaret HARMON
 - The current working theory has these as the parent's of Peter H PARKER, bc 1805 KY.
 - Margaret HARMON had a brother Peter HARMON; our Peter was probably named after this maternal uncle.
- Peter was most often recorded as Peter H.
- In his 1873 will, he recorded himself as Peter H.
- In three real estate transactions in Cherokee County, ALABAMA, 1848, 1850, 1852, he was clearly recorded as "Harman Parker of Cherokee County, Alabama."
- In addition, the name Harman/Harmon is used several other times in Peter's family tree:
 - Peter Harmon PARKER, b 22 Feb 1872 AK, son of Russell Leonidas PARKER son of Peter Harman PARKER
 - George Harmon PARKER b 05 Aug 1919 TX, son of George Branson PARKER, son of Russell Leonidas PARKER, son of Peter Harman PARKER

There was concern that the Harman PARKER who purchased land in Cherokee County, ALABAMA was <u>Harmonious Napoleon PARKER</u>, son of John Burns PARKER, who has been proved related to Peter H PARKER, bc 1805 KY, by yDNA. (<u>PARKER Family DNA Project, Family Group #41</u>)

However, there is no evidence Harmonious Napoleon PARKER or his father John Burns PARKER ever lived in Cherokee County, ALABAMA.

- According to his headstone, <u>John Burns PARKER</u> relocated from East TENNESSEE to Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI in 1836, raised his family there, was enumerated there in the 1850, 1860, 1870 and 1880 US Census, died there in 1887, and is buried there; the <u>linked webpage</u> has a collection documents for John Burns PARKER.
- John Burns PARKER's son <u>Harmonious Napoleon PARKER</u> was born in Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI in 1856, married in Houston, Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI, was enumerated in the US Census in Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI in 1860, 1870 and 1880, married in Houston, Chickasaw Co, MISSISSIPPI in 1883, fathered three children born in MISSISSIPPI, and died in 1889 at the age of 33 in Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI.

In addition, Harmonious Napoleon PARKER was born in Chickasaw County, MISSISSIPPI in 1856, eight years AFTER the first purchase of land in Cherokee County, ALABAMA by the "Harman PARKER."

- NOTE: In the household enumerated immediately before Peter's family was Hiram PERRY, bc 1780 NC and wife Mary; two years before, Peter H. purchased land -- probably the land on which he lived in the 1850 census -- as Harman PARKER; it is possible the enumerator confused the two names and labeled Harman as Hiram.

Just to be a trouble maker, there was a Hiram PARKER who lived in Barbour Co, ALABAMA during the time our Peter H. and family lived in Cherokee Co, ALABAMA -- about 200 miles north of Barbour County.
